### Comments from children

#### **Children reported that:**

They felt safe, and had adults that they named who they could talk to  
They had a good knowledge of world issues, particularly in Key Stage 2 and could talk about issues in Paris and Syria. Children reported that adults were always willing to talk to them about current affairs.

They felt that incidents of bullying were rare in the school and that adults supported them well – a zero tolerance policy existed.

Children talked about all the ways that adults supported them to be safe and happy ie strangers do not come into school, staff dealt with medical issues well, there were no hazards. Children commented about the things that they enjoyed, ie topic work, and the wider enrichment opportunities.

#### **How the school will take this forward?**

Where children did not understand the dangers of being in a gang, or the terminology, support to be addressed at an age appropriate level.

Children raised some concerns about the gate being opened by other children and the school will talk to all children in assembly.
