The following are some of the things we will be learning about this half term....



English...

In writing using a range of inspirational texts, including those linked to our IPC topic, and animations to develop writing in different genres including descriptive writing using figurative language and newspaper reports.

In reading, developing the skills of prediction, clarify, inference, summarising and making links and applying these to comprehension questions.

In grammar, punctuation and spelling, using relative clauses to extend sentences, using commas and brackets to embed relative clauses and continuing to learn the Y5/6 key words.



Maths...

Using the formal written method to multiply and divide by two-digit numbers.

Developing confidence with using and applying fractions in different contexts. For example, ordering, simplifying and investigating equivalence.

Converting between different units of metric measurement, for example length and weight
Using all four operations to solve problems involving measurement.

Investigating perimeter and area and calculating perimeter and area of rectangles.
Continuing to test multiplication knowledge.
