The following are some of the things we will be learning about this half term...



English...

The year 1 phonics screening check 2018 will commence week beginning 11th June, for that week only, so it's crucial that your child is in school every day. This half term we will be reading 'The Story Tree' as well as non-fiction books linked to our IPC topic 'What's it made of?'. The children will learn how to write for different purposes, eg. stories, posters, information leaflets and poems. Children will continue to have phonics lessons focussing on fluency, comprehension, spellings and writing. They will review prefixes and suffixes, how to form plurals of nouns, past tense of verbs and punctuation marks. Please read daily with your child. Try to read at least 1 non-fiction book each week.



Maths...

This half term we will be focusing on numbers to 100 and solving word problems. They will work on recognizing, reading and writing numbers up to 100 (and beyond) in figures and words. Children will add within 100 by making tens first and represent tens and ones in a place value chart. They will also review how to compare numbers up to 100. They will be introduced to coins and notes and working out amounts. They will learn how to add and subtract in pence and pounds. They will be introduced to multiplication through repeated addition and making multiplication stories. They will also learn how to divide by sharing equally and grouping. They will learn how to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour.

We will be learning about:

- What objects are made of
- How we use different materials
- How to test materials
- How materials are the same or different
- How we can group materials
- How to choose materials for specific uses
- Where materials come from
- How to plan and design a classroom makeover
- About the materials used to build our homes

Talk to your child about the various types of materials found in and around your home and the wider environment.
